## "WHEN JESUS IS KING" SENIOR PASTOR SHAWN CLARKE

Q. In a world that is opposed to King Jesus, what does it look like when Jesus is the <u>KING</u> of your life?

When Jesus is King there are <u>LABORS</u> prompted by <u>LOVE</u>. (verses 3)

When Jesus is King there are <u>WORKS</u> produced by faith. (verses 3-9)

What work did the Thessalonians do that was produced by faith?

- 1. They truly *received* the Gospel. (v. 5-6)
- 2. They became *imitators* of the apostles and of Jesus. (verses 6-8)
- 3. They *turned* to God from *idols* to serve the living and true God. (v. 9)

When Jesus is King there is a <u>STEADFASTNESS</u> to our <u>HOPE</u>. (verses 3, 10)
