The Pathway to Life is..... James 4:6-12 (Part 2)

Review:

- Matthew 7:14 (ESV) - *For the gate is narrow **and the way is hard** that leads to life, and those who find it are few.*
- The pathway to life is marked with humble dependence and submissive repentance.
- The pathway to exaltation is on the back country road called humility.

Submissive Repentance. (James 4:7-9; 11-12)

1. Submit...
2. Resist...
3. Draw Near...

Repentance (Matt. 4:17; Acts 17:30)

True Christian repentance involves a: (1) heartfelt conviction of sin, (2) contrition over the offense to God, 3) turning away from the sinful way of life, and 4) walking in a God-honoring way.
