Psalm 76 Vows and Gifts to a Majestic Fearsome Judge

Psalm 76 Structure:

- 1-3: God dwells with His people and has given them peace. He fought their battles and won.
- 4-6: He is majestic and glorious, more powerful than anything or anyone else.
- 7-10: He also judges, but saves those who are humble. He is to be feared.
- 11-12: We should make vows to Him, and keep them, and we should give Him gifts.

2 Corinthians 5:9. So whether we are at home or away, we make it our aim to please him. 10. For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil.

Ephesians 2:10. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.
