THE BOOK OF Ruth

Ruth 3 The Pursuit of Redemption

Honoring and Obeying God's Word

- Leader: This is God's Word...
- Congregation: it is to be <u>believed</u> in all that it <u>teaches</u>, <u>obeyed</u> in all it <u>requires</u> and <u>trusted</u> in all it <u>promises</u>.
- All: Thanks be to God.

Jesus has already done all the work to <u>secure</u> our <u>redemption</u>; we need only to <u>humbly ask</u> Him to receive it.

Naomi's plan for redemption involved a marriage. (1-5)

- She focused on God's Word (Deut. 25:5)
- She focused on other people. (Ruth 3:1)

Ruth's <u>pursuit</u> of redemption involved a <u>humble request</u>. (6-9)

Ezekiel 16:8

Boaz promises to provide redemption while **proving** to be a man of **purity**. (10-18)
