The Divine Design for Human Flourishing (Part 2)

Review: Delaying adulthood endangers the family. (Matt. 5:16)

Disregarding roles makes families dysfunctional. (1 Cor. 12:14-15, 18-19; Eph. 5:22-31)

...we must assume the right posture. (Phil. 2:5-7)

...to embrace our unique God given roles. (Eph. 5:22-31)

Preliminary thoughts:

- 1. Marriage is between one man and one woman. (Gen. 2:24)
- 2. Cohabitation is not the same as marriage and is morally dangerous (Heb. 13:4)
- 3. God not only invented the <u>concept</u> of marriage; but each of our <u>individual</u> marriages. (Matt. 19:6)

Husbands and Fathers: Men are called to <u>lead sacrificially</u> with <u>love</u>. (Eph. 5:25-26)

- We must **model** the word while we **minister** the word.
- In family worship, be <u>brief</u>, be <u>regular</u> and be <u>flexible</u>. Donald Whitney

Wives and Mothers: Women are <u>custom fit</u> to <u>help</u> their family flourish. (Gen. 2:18; Ps. 33:20; 121:1-2; Prov. 14:1; Eph. 5:33)

Children: Kids <u>trust</u> God's sovereignty by <u>submitting</u> to authority. (Ex. 20:12; John 14:15; Col. 3:23)

Take away: For families to flourish each member must assume the right posture of humility and embrace their unique God given roles.
