### LIFE GROUP/PERSONAL STUDY QUESTIONS

- 1. What impacted you most from your overall experience with FCC on Sunday?
- 2. Read <u>John 8:11</u>, <u>Romans 8:1</u> and <u>1 John 1:9</u>. If you are in Christ, what stirs in your heart when Jesus says, "Neither do I condemn you"? Where have you been carrying condemnation that Christ has already cancelled? Is there anything you still need to confess?
- 3. Divorce is not a quick fix to a relational problem, typically more problems arise. What are some consequences of divorce? (mental, physical, spiritual, social, relational)?
- 4. In a time of conflict do you view your spouse as an ally (someone with whom you can work toward a common goal) or an enemy (someone you are actively opposed and hostile towards)? When your next conflict arises, how can you together attack the presented problem instead of each other? Brainstorm with your spouse <u>before</u> the next conflict begins!
- 5. If there are <u>seemingly</u> irreconcilable difference that appear to be present in the relationship, ask "What have I contributed or am I contributing to the upheaval that threatens to undo what God has done in bringing us together."
- 6. What would believing and acting on <u>Ephesians 3:20</u> look like in your relationships?
- 7. Have you been adopted into the family of God (<u>John 1:12</u>; <u>Gal. 3:26</u>; <u>1 John 3:1</u>)? If so, how is this more than just a consolation prize?
- 8. How did the Holy Spirit prompt you on Sunday at FCC?



# The Divine Design for Human Flourishing (Part 3)

#### Review:

- \* Delaying adulthood endangers the family. (Matt. 5:16)
- \* Disregarding roles makes families dysfunctional. (1 Cor. 12:14-15, 18-19; Eph. 5:22-31)

Divorce destroys families. (Mark 10:1-9; Luke 19:40; Ps. 103:12)
