Week 2: Philippians 1:18–30

READ the passage together. Philippians 1:18-30

PONDER . In Philippians 1:19, what does Paul say will be the means of his expected deliverance? _____ and _____.

1. Paul believed his deliverance would come through prayer and the Spirit's help. Who or what are you praying for consistently? How might Paul's understanding of deliverance encourage you to keep praying and not give up?
2. Paul wanted most of all for "Christ to be honored in his body" (v. 20). How is Christ currently "honored" or "dishonored" in your life?
3. Paul set aside his good and godly desire, to "be with Christ" (v. 23), for the sake of others progress and joy in the faith (v. 25). Where are you currently prioritizing your preferences over the spiritual good of others?
4. Citizenship in heaven calls for our highest allegiance. What earthly things competes most with your allegiance to Christ?
5. What was the most "impactful moment" for you at FCC this week? (examples: during corporate worship, gathering with the family, a Spirit prompting during the message, etc.)

PRAY. Share one area of your life where you hope for deliverance and then assign people in your group to pray for each specific request. Use Philippians 1:9-11 as a base text for prayer.

ACT. Who is one person you can pray for daily this week. How do you plan on letting them know you prayed for them for 7 days straight?
