Week 11: Philippians 4:14–23

READ the passage together. Philippians 4:14-23

PONDER: At least how many times did the Philippians support Paul's Gospel spreading ministry? (vs 16) _____.

1. The main teaching point of the passage was: "Our generosity pleases God, blesses others, and brings blessings back to us." How have you seen this to be true?
2. When we internalize the Gospel, we become people who embody the idea of, it is "more blessed to give than to receive." is this true of you?
3. Why do you think hidden acts of generosity are especially pleasing to God? Have you ever experienced joy from giving anonymously or sacrificially?
4. Ask the Lord: "Lord, what have You entrusted to me that You want me to steward more faithfully for Your Kingdom?"
5. Philippians 4:19 promises that God will supply every need according to His riches in Christ. What needs are hardest for you to trust God with right now?
6. The last command in Philippians is to "Greet one another." How can you get to know more names here at FCC?

PRAY. Pray for the spread of the Gospel through our missionaries and church staff.

ACT. Establish and implement a plan to consistently and cheerfully give to Gospel spreading ministries. **BONUS:** Do a random act of generosity or kindness in secret to someone!
