

Week 3: Psalm 77

READ the passage together.

PONDER . While the Psalms always praise God, they often showcase the painful experiences of the human soul. Life and Spirituality are not always a simple path to follow.

1. When God feels silent, what is my first instinct? To hide my pain or bring it honestly to him and to others? What do you do?
2. How do my memories of “better” days affect my faith today? Do they deepen my despair or drive me back to God?
3. Which of Asaph’s six questions do you secretly wrestle with? What insight does this show you about your view of God?
4. Where in your life do you need to trust God’s character even when you can’t see his footprints?
5. Looking back on your life, where have you seen God’s invisible hand of guidance?

PRAY . Psalms are also Prayers. In each one the Psalmist *brings their plea to God*. Take some time bringing your own pleas before the Lord.

ACT . What is one intentional practice that you can build into your life to help you “remember the works of the Lord” when your emotions or soul are discouraged and stressed?

Psalm 77 **Faith for the Night Season**

Main theme: When God feels far away, remember what he has done then make a decision; for he is still working, simply unseen.

I. What do you do when God Feels Absent? (verses 1-9)

Memory can make the Present Hurt more. (verses 3-6)

What happens when our Questions Turn Dark. (verse 7-9)

II. The Turning Point: God is still working even when you can't see Him. His silence is not his Absence.
