

Week 5: Psalm 110

READ the passage together. [Psalm 110](#)

PONDER . The New Testament repeatedly quotes [Psalm 110](#) to explain who Jesus is. Why do you think the early Christians considered this psalm so essential for understanding Christ?

1. Verse 2 says that Jesus rules “in the midst of His enemies.” How does Christ’s present reign encourage you when the world seems increasingly opposed to Him or to the gospel?
2. Verse 3 says, “Your people will offer themselves freely.” What does it practically look like to offer yourself freely to Jesus in everyday life? What competes for that devotion?
3. Is there an area of your life where you know Christ is King, but you have been slow to willingly submit to His rule? What would faithful obedience look like this week?

PRAY . Spend time thanking Jesus for being both your eternal King who has conquered every enemy and your eternal Priest who has reconciled you to God. Ask Him to deepen your willing devotion, strengthen your obedience, and give you courage to lovingly call others to trust Him before the day of His final judgment.

ACT . This week, intentionally surrender one specific area of your life to Christ’s rule. Tell someone how you plan to obey Him.
