

Week 6: Psalm 14

READ the passage together. [Psalm 14](#)

PONDER . Psalm 14 starts with a dramatic rhetorical depiction of ‘the fool’. This ‘fool’ serves as a type-cast for what kind of people?

1. How is the fool different from ‘God’s people’? (vs. 5&7)
Compare the two. Example: “they have no knowledge... but we do”, “they do not call upon the Lord... but we do!” etc.
2. What practices for your faith walk can you learn from this comparison?
3. How do you live differently because you are certain about where you will spend eternity? Do you live differently?
4. When given the chance to stand for truth, how does your desire for approval affect your response to the situation?
5. Where can you find the encouragement to stand firm when people oppose your faith? How can you be a source of that encouragement for others?

PRAY . What areas of weakness in your life does Satan attack most easily? It could be an area of sin or a pain point in your life.

ACT . Ask God to grow your strength in those areas this week. Reach out to a trusted friend (or Pastor) and confess any sin that persists, or share that pain with someone, inviting them to journey with you as you face it. As Christians we don’t walk alone.
