

Week 11: Psalm 94

READ the passage together. Psalm 94

PONDER . Share a story with your group about a time you physically slipped. (hydroplaned, ice, banana peel???)

1. Psalm 94:14 says, *"The LORD will not forsake his people; he will not abandon his heritage."* What circumstances tend to make you question whether God is really with you?
2. "For every look at yourself, take ten looks at Christ."
What do you think it looks like practically to do this? What is the difference between honestly examining your sin and becoming consumed with your sin?

PRAY . Choose 1 of the 7 consoling thoughts presented in Psalm 94 and spend time thanking God for the comfort it promises.

ACT . Putting this into practice, fill out this simple chart that will provide you with a game plan for when you feel like your initial thoughts are causing you to slip.

For example: the thought...

- * "I'm alone," turns into, "God will never forsake me."
- * "God is against me," turns into "God loves me and is restoring me."
- * "I have failed again," turns into, "My hope is in Christ's sinlessness, not mine."
- * "Why bother following God?" turns into, "It really is worth it to follow God."

As families break free from generational poverty, our hope is that we would be reminded together that we are not simply witnesses—we are an essential part of the story God is writing.

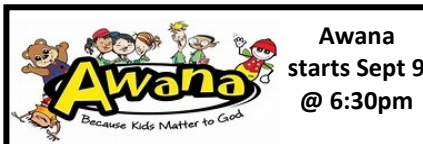
Come be inspired to live from your identity in Christ, and leave a legacy that changes lives for generations!

*"When I thought, "My foot slips," your steadfast love, O Lord, held me up.
When the cares of my heart are many, your consolations cheer my soul."-
Psalm 94:18-*

VIEW: When our cares compound, let His consolations control.

- # 1 - Every wrong will be righted by the God of vengeance.
(Ps. 94:1-2; Prov. 15:3)
- # 2 - Every affliction we face is momentary.
(Ps. 94:3; 2 Cor. 4:17-18; 1 Pet. 5:10)
- # 3 - Every need we have is heard, seen and cared for by God.
(Ps. 94:9; Gen. 16:13; Rev. 7:17)
- # 4 - God will never forsake us because He paid the rent due to reside in us.
 - Ps. 94:14; Deut. 32:9-12; Eph. 3:17
- # 5 - God disciplines us to protect us from further hardships.
 - Ps. 94:12-13; Prov. 1:8-10, 32-33, 21:16, 29:1; 1 John 5:3; John 15:1-2
- # 6 - Our hope is not in our sinlessness, it is in the sinlessness of Jesus.
 - Ps. 94:16-17; Acts 2:24; Heb. 9:12; 2 Tim. 4:16-17; 1 Pet. 5:8; Rev. 12:10; Heb. 7:25
- # 7 - It really is worth it to follow God.
 - Ps. 94:20-23
